As we have announced, Association 70 is planning an encampment for this coming spring. We had our first planning session on December 15, 2008. We had lots of spirited discussion and are all very excited to be planning this awesome event for our Girl Scouts of Loudoun County. As this encampment is for the benefit of all of us, we are asking for at least one person from each service unit to be part of our planning team. We all want to have lots of fun and enjoyment at this event and need help to put everything together. That being said, we need to fill some key roles in order to proceed with our plans. They are as follows:

Health and Safety Coordination - Responsibilities will include locating 2nd level first aiders, scheduling troop first aiders to help thru the weekend, sanitation (ordering porta potties), and coordinating the parking lot 'attendants' for Sat morning as troops are arriving.

Food Coordinator - Responsibilities will include planning, ordering, and serving 4 meals: 3 on Sat. and breakfast on Sunday morning. Friday dinner will be the responsibility of the individual troops.

Activities Coordinator - Responsibilities will include planning, ordering supplies for, and recruiting help to run the centers. This will probably include teen troops who would like to run a center or earn leadership hours. Planning a schedule of participating troops for the flag ceremonies and opening and closing ceremonies.

Camp Layout Coordinator - Responsibilities will include where everything will go and be done, including tents, and activities.

Communications Coordinator - Responsibilities will include keeping troops up to date about how the plans are progressing and keeping leaders informed about what they need to do and bring to have a successful encampment.

These jobs will need to be filled in order to proceed further with our plans. Our next planning meeting will be Thursday, January 15, 2009 in the Leesburg office at 7 pm.
